**New resource available : Infographic series "Focus on Francophone immigration" (2010 - 2020)**

Regina, May 13th, 2020 – The *Francophone Immigration Network of Saskatchewan (Réseau en immigration francophone de la Saskatchewan (RIF-SK))* now offers a new resource. The Network has developed a series of infographics highlighting data on Francophone immigration in Gravelbourg, Moose Jaw, Prince Albert, Regina, and Saskatoon.
