### *Réseau en immigration francophone de la Saskatchewan* **Launch for the 5<sup>th</sup> National Francophone Immigration Week**

Regina, October 18, 2017 – The *Réseau en immigration francophone de la Saskatchewan* (RIF-SK) is pleased to announce the launch of the 5<sup>th</sup> National Francophone Immigration Week, October 27, 2017. The event will take place at the *Rotonde* in the *Cité universitaire francophone*, University of Regina, from 2 P.M. to 3 P.M. This event is open to everyone.

The National Francophone Immigration Week is an initiative of the FCFA and the RIFs. The campaign is made possible by the financial support of Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada, and the participation of many partners. This initiative is inspired by the Francophone Immigration Week in Atlantic Canada, organized by the *Comité atlantique sur l'immigration francophone* (CAIF) in 2012.

The fifth edition of the National Francophone Immigration Week will take place from October 29<sup>th</sup> to November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017.
